Our Health and Safety Policy is to provide employees, visitors and sub-contractors with a safe place to work and to prevent any accidents or cases of work-related ill health.

We will do this by:

1. Performing Risk Assessments and continuously reviewing activities to identify hazards and controls needed to provide a safe work place.
2. Provide training in safe working practices and ensure everyone is aware and understands the hazards and controls associated with the work the do and in the work place.
3. Use signage to remind people of the hazards and any control needed.
4. Conduct health surveillance where identified in Risk Assessments.
5. Making employees aware of the importance of their contribution to the effectiveness of good health and safety practices and their contribution to maintaining a safe workplace.
6. Reviewing this policy annually or when changes occur that may introduce new hazards or raise the risk level, whichever comes soonest.
7. Consult with employees on health and safety matters via health and safety committee meetings monthly.
